


<p>3</p>	<p>r-controlled</p> 	<p>bossy R</p> <p>1 vowel followed by a R.</p> <p>The vowel and R appear in the same syllable.</p>	<p>air</p> <p>tur/nip car/rot</p>
<p>4</p>	<p>vowel team</p> 	<p>ai, ay, ee, ea, oa, oo, oi, ow, oy, ou, ie, ei igh, ow, ue</p>	<p>They appear in the same syllable</p> <p>bea/ten goo/gle boy/ish</p>
<p>5</p>	<p>vowel silent e</p> 	<p>long sound</p> <p>vce</p>	<p>cake flute</p>
<p>6</p>	<p>consonant - le</p> 	<p>le appears at the end with a consonant</p>	<p>bub/ble cir/cle cas/tle</p>
